GENESCO MATCHING GIFTS PROGRAM GUIDELINES

The Genesco Matching Gifts Program enhances an employee's and director's financial contribution to a favorite not-for-profit organization, and allows the Company to fulfill its commitment to support agencies in communities where employees work and live. Genesco full-time and part-time employees and directors are eligible for the matching gift program. The Company will match up to four donations to an accredited 501(c)(3) non-profit organization for a combined total of \$1,000 each fiscal year.

To submit a matching funds request, please send the matching gifts request form with your donation to the non-profit agency. Forms are available on the Genesco intranet or by contacting Corporate Relations. The non-profit agency will then send the matching gifts request directly to the Company. Donations will be processed quarterly.

As a matter of corporate policy, Genesco <u>does not</u> support individuals or their individual projects, private foundations, political activities, advertising or sponsorships. <u>The Company reserves the right to deny match requests in its sole discretion</u>.

The following are *excluded* from the Matching Gift program:

- 1. Schools below the college level, including daycare centers. Matching gifts to annual funds under the college level will be considered.
- 2. Scholarship programs, outside of the Company's employee scholarship program.
- 3. Disease-specific organizations seeking support for specific or individual research projects and programs; or donations to biomedical or clinical research. Donations to a general fund of a disease specific organization, for example, American Heart Association, Juvenile Diabetes, etc., are not excluded.
- 4. Hospitals.
- 5. Newsletters, magazines or books.
- 6. Trips or tours.
- 7. Projects or programs of religious, fraternal, athletic or veterans groups when the primary beneficiaries of such undertakings would be their own members.
- 8. Endowments.
- 9. Social events or similar fundraising activities.
- 10. Pledges for walks and telethons.
